UPDATE! CATECHISM CLASSES

approach to Catechism of our children, through fun and inspirational learning.

UPDATE! FABRIC ISSUES & BUILDING FUND COLLECTION

I am sure all of you are also very much aware of the serious fabric issues that Sacred Heart has:

- moss on the interior of the Church and falling debris due to water ingress
- **plants growing outside on the wall and in the gutters** which contributes to wet walls and moss formation (we need to hire a cherry picker to remove plants and repoint damage caused, and treat roots with plant killing chemicals – we were quoted for ca. £1000 – the **2nd collections will go for this purpose**)
- the disabled toilet is out of order, etc. **PLUMBER needed for looking at why the Disabled toilet is not working!**
- external lights not working, emergency lights broken
- **Recent completed works:** kitchen ceiling refurbished (ca. £300); gutters cleared, plants removed from the wall and damaged parts repointed, using a cherry picker (estimated at £1000)
- **Upcoming works:** roof area check and remedial works to stop water ingress

To resolve these problems we need to build up sufficient funds over the years. Therefore after consulting the Parish Pastoral Council on Thursday I propose that we have a building fund collection 1x per month on the last Sunday of the month. Thank you for your generosity: Fr. Gabor
