43 4TH NOVEMBER UPDATE ON FABRIC ISSUES & BUILDING FUND CONTRIBUTION

Works done last week (all costs include VAT): ELECTRICITY & LIGHT WAS INTRODUCED INTO GARAGES & CCTV WAS INSTALLED AROUND HALL & CHURCH & PHONE CABLE WAS REPAIRED & ENTRY LIGHT WAS INSTALLED FOR CHURCH (Total: £ 596.06); CHURCH ROOF REPAIR BEGAN (costs depend on what is found and repaired).

Works to be done: Identify sources of water ingress (which enables moss development) and eliminate them (especially by eliminating leaking through the roof and walls); Fix the disabled toilet (FUNDS ALREADY DONATED BY YOU)

To address these problems, we need to build up sufficient funds over the years. Therefore, after consulting the Parish Pastoral Council I propose that we have a collection 1x per month on the last Sunday of the month to address these issues. Thank you for your generosity: A BIG THANK YOU TO ANOTHER ANONYM DONOR FOR THE £100 HE DONATED TO SACRED HEART FOR THE ROOF REPAIR AND A HUGE THANK YOU TO ALL OF YOU FOR LAST WEEK'S LARGE DONATION OF £701.36. I have never had such a large donation in any of my previous parishes. Together we can achieve great things.
