Gabor wish to make all aware of how much **EXPENSES** and income we have each month: Bills – Electricity and Gas for the Church, Priest's house, small Church halls & Large Hall in total: **£1000/ month**, Office expenses (photocopier hire & photocopying, subscriptions, Internet & Telephone, stationary, etc.) **£510/month**; Priest's House running expenses (Council Tax, Telephone, Internet, TV Licence, etc.): **£273/month**; Maintenance & Repairs: **£1460/month**; Levy: **£767/month**; Clergy Support contribution: **£641/month**; Loan repayment: **£600/month**, Other expenses: **£410/month** **TOTAL EXPENSES= £5600/month** - **MONTHLY INCOME:** Offertory collections: £ 1920/month; Standing order. Etc.: **£450/month**; Tax rebates: **£500/month**; Income from

flat & halls rentals: **£920/month**; Fundraising **£320/month**; Other income: **£830/month**: TOTAL INCOME: **£4600/month**. So if you could please increase your weekly collection donation **just by £1** that would make a big difference. Thank you! Fr. Gabor
