The month of September is dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows, whose memorial the Church celebrates on September 15. September. Our Lady's co-operation in the redemption of the world gives us a fresh view of her magnificence. Neither the Immaculate Conception nor the Assumption will give us a higher idea of Mary's exaltation than the title of co-redemptrix. Her sorrows were not necessary for the redemption of the world, but in the counsels of God they were inseparable from it. They belong to the integrity of the divine plan. These are the 7 sorrows of Mary: 1. The prophecy of Simeon in the temple (a sword will pierce your soul), 2. the escape to Egypt, 3. The search for the lost child in Jerusalem, 4. Mary meets his son on the way of the Cross, 5. Standing at the foot of the cross, 6. The crucifixion of Jesus and taking him down from the cross, 7. Assisting at the burial of Christ.

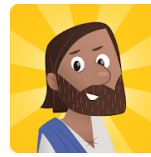

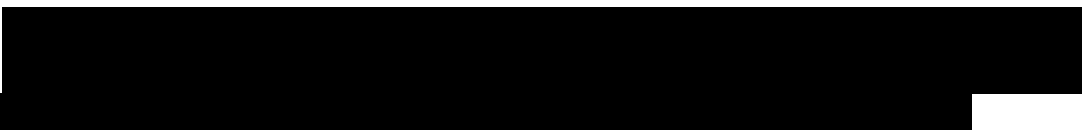
